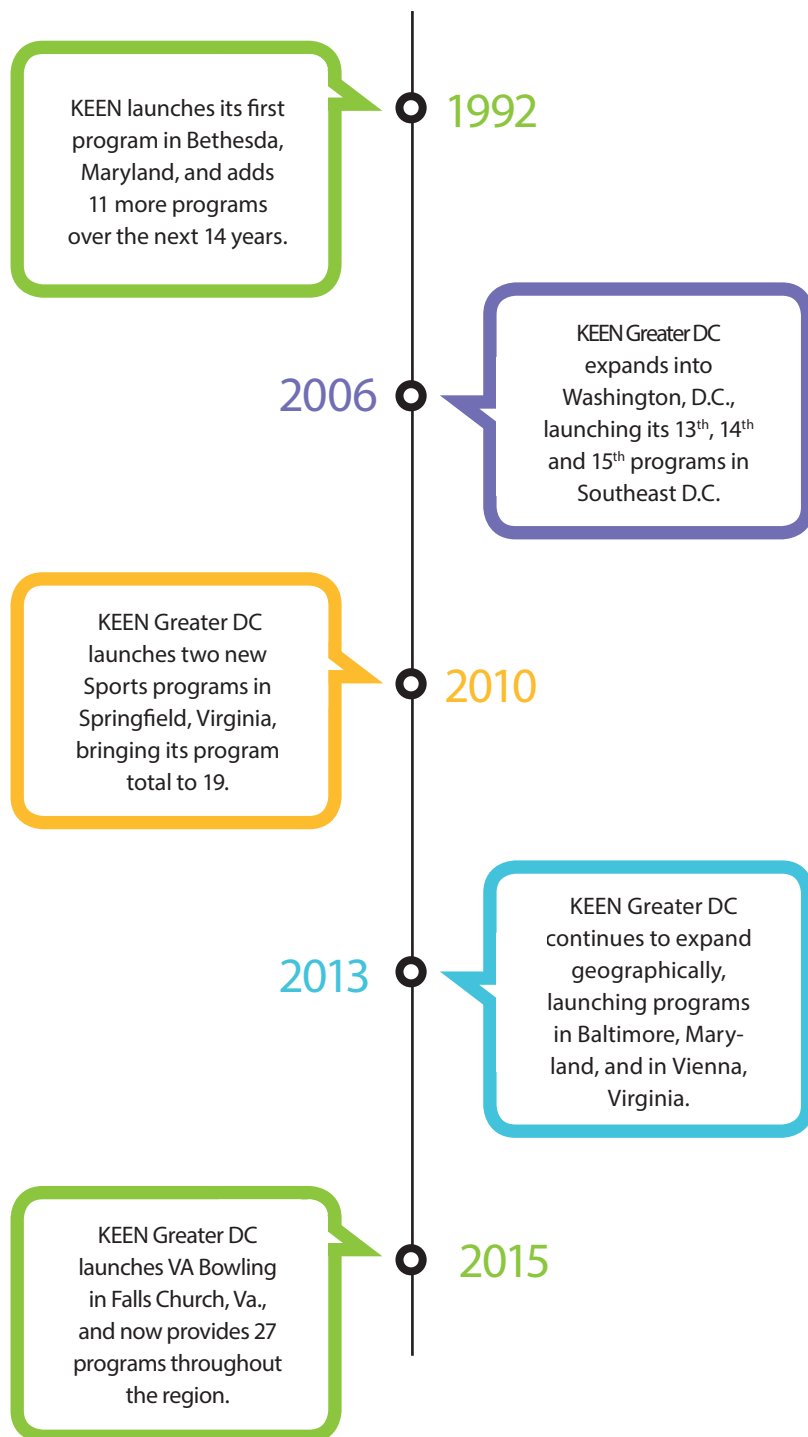

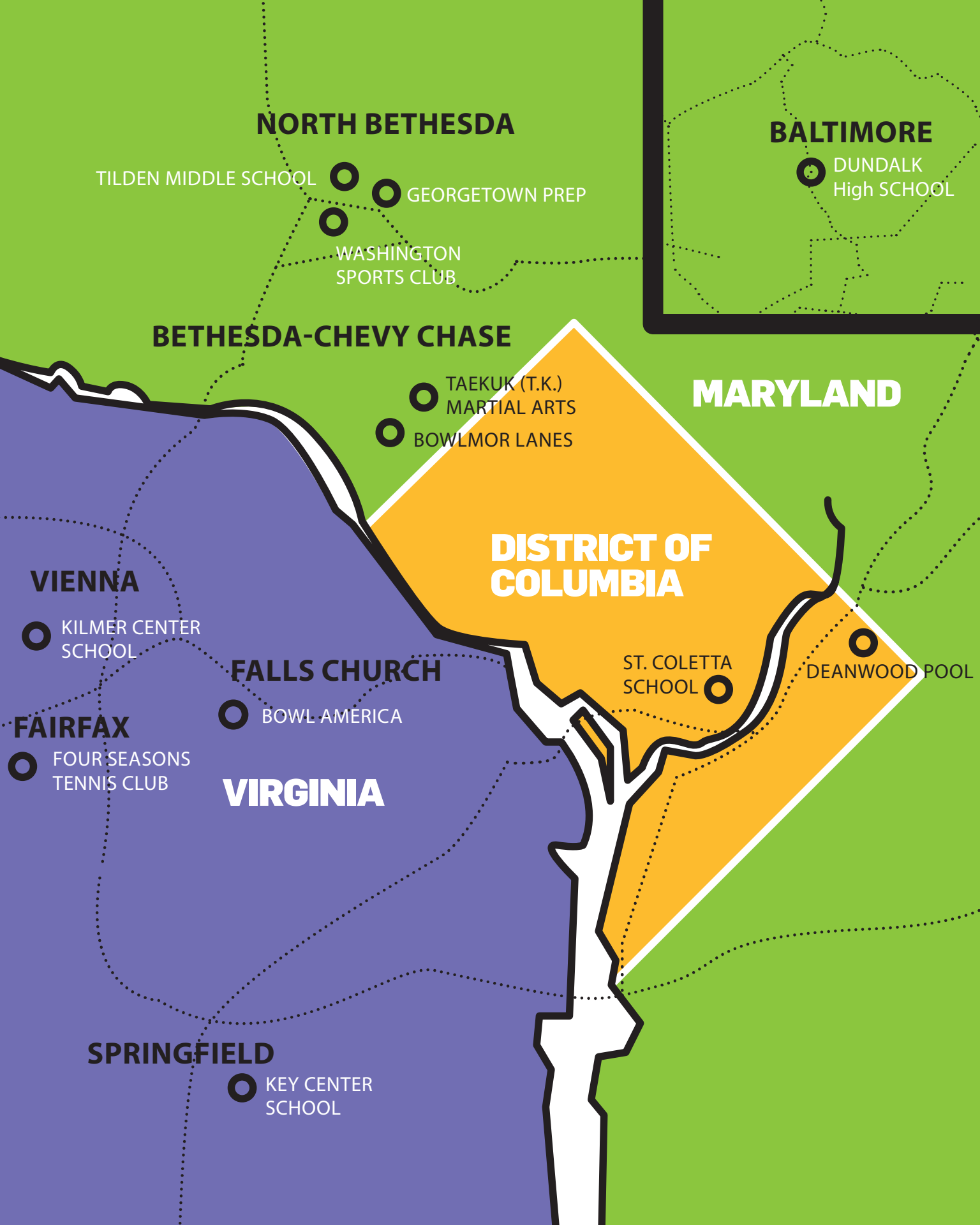


ABOUT KEEN Greater DC
