






As word spread, the need for KEEN—a recreational program where everyone is accepted and celebrated for who they are and no one is judged—became immediately apparent. In the years since, KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore has expanded its free-of-charge programming to include bowling, swimming, tae kwon do and more, offering 12 programs in Montgomery County, Maryland. In 2013, in partnership with Johns Hopkins University, we expanded our geographical reach and launched Sports programs in Baltimore!




