This year, we celebrated our 25th anniversary of providing free-of-charge programs for young people with significant disabilities. KEEN started in 1992 with just one sports program and only a handful of children and volunteers. In the 25 years since, both volunteer and funding support has grown tremendously, allowing us to expand program offerings, extend our reach from Montgomery County, Maryland, to the District of Columbia, Baltimore and Northern Virginia, and increase the number of programs and young people we serve exponentially.

To commemorate our silver jubilee, we established a new bowling program in Baltimore, created a new sports program in Arlington, Virginia, and began a partnership with the Edlavitch DCJCC to build a new Zumba program in the District of Columbia. With the addition of these three new programs, we were able to enroll more participants, and today KEEN has 30 programs in 15 locations, serving more than 500 very special young people!

None of that would be possible without the generous support of KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore sponsors, contributors, volunteers and our many friends who make KEEN's programs possible year after year. All of our donors and Silver Stars are listed in this annual report.

As we begin another quarter century, we hold firm to our promise to grow, expand and continue to serve all young people with special needs regardless of the severity of their disabilities, and entirely free of charge. With your support, there's no limit to what KEEN can accomplish!

KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore started in 1992 with a very simple concept: Bring together volunteers from the community and young people with significant developmental and physical disabilities, pair them one to one, and let them discover how to explore their abilities and have fun. With this concept, over the past 25 years, KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore has launched 30 free-of-charge programs in the District of Columbia, Maryland and Virginia.





THE FIRST PROGRAM KEEN GREATER DC-BALTIMORE brings to any new area is Sports. As with all KEEN programs, Sports provides a non-competitive opportunity for KEEN athletes to play with a variety of sports equipment in their own way and at their own pace while having the support and friendship of a one-on-one volunteer coach.

KEEN athletes and their coaches may throw a basketball, kick a soccer ball, bounce on large therapy balls, pull each other on indoor scooters or find other ways to have fun with the variety of sports equipment provided.

In 2006, KEEN brought its Sports program to Southeast Washington, D.C., where it was met with such enthusiasm that Swim, Music, Basketball Clinics and Soccer Clinics soon followed. In 2017, in celebration of our 25th anniversary and in partnership with the Edlavitch Jewish Community Center of Washington DC (EDCJCC), we launched Zumba Fitness for young adults.

PROGRAM, launched in 1992 with five KEEN athletes and a handful of volunteer coaches in North Bethesda. As word spread, the need for KEEN—a recreational program where everyone is accepted and celebrated for who they are and no one is judged became immediately apparent. In the years since, KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore has expanded its free-of-charge programming to include bowling, swimming, tae kwon do and more, offering 12 programs in Montgomery County, Maryland. In 2013, in partnership with Johns Hopkins University, we expanded our geographical reach and launched Sports programs in Baltimore! In 2017, in celebration of our 25th anniversary, we launched Baltimore Bowling.






