

ABOUT US

KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore started in 1992 with a very simple concept: Bring together volunteers from the community and young people with significant developmental and physical disabilities, pair them one to one, and let them discover how to explore their abilities and have fun. With this concept over the past 30 years, KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore has launched 38 free-of-charge in-person programs in the District of Columbia, Maryland and Virginia. Amid the pandemic, KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore launched 7 virtual programs, allowing athletes and volunteers to stay connected.

KEEN launches its first 1992 program in Bethesda, MD, and adds 11 more programs over the next 14 years. KEEN Greater DC expands into Washington, D.C., 2006 launching its 13th, 14th and 15th programs in Southeast D.C. **KEEN Greater DC** launches two new Sports programs in Springfield, VA, 2010 bringing its program total to 19. KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore 2013 launches programs in Baltimore. KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore launches Virginia Bowling 2015 in Falls Church, VA, and now provides 27 programs throughout the region. **KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore** celebrates its Silver 2017 Anniversary and increases to 30 programs, launching Sports in Arlington, VA, **KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore** Bowling in Baltimore, MD, and launches Yoga in Silver Spring Zumba in Washington, D.C. and Teens Tae Kwon Do in Chevy Chase, MD; Zumba in Arlington and Vienna and Teens 2018 Bowling in Falls Church, VA. **KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore** 2019 launches Yoga in Washington, D.C. and ZamDance in Chevy KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore Chase, MD. launches virtual programs for all in March, a week after having to suspend in-person programs 2020 due to COVID. 2021 KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore continues with online programs and resumes KEEN Greater DC-Baltimore in-person sessions. **launches Sports for Young** Adults in Washington, DC, and partners with DeMatha 2022 Catholic High School and launches Basketball in Prince George's County.
